- (6) Online Application will be printed out by Graduate school, So you don't submit it.
- (7) Your documents must be arrived by May 31 (Fri) 3pm in The Graduate School office.
- (8) In case there are missing documents, the applicants must take responsibility and the admission/entrance will be cancelled.


